Please read the manual to avoid mistakes!

- Find the middle of the fabric by connecting the arrows on the chart (T2).
- The embroidery is done with 2-strand cross-stitch of wollen/acrylic yarn or 3-strand cross-stitch of cotton stranded threads.
- The work will look good if all upper stitches are inclined in one direction (T3).
- Avoid knots. Hide the thread ends under the stitches of the reverse side (T4).
- Finish the borders of a napkin by making a row of supporting stitches (T5) in 8 cm distance from the center of every napkin. Choose the colors of the stitches according to your design: green for cucumber, red for tomatoes, maroon for pepper.
- Iron the finished embroidery from the reverse side.
- Cut the excess of the fabric leaving 2 cm for fringes. Make the fringes by pulling the outermost threads from the fabric.
- If you wish to use napkins to decorate jars, you need to make special string laces with the excess thread. Take 2 pieces of 100 cm of 5-stranded threads, make a knot and twist them tightly in different directions (T6). Don't let go of the plaid you created, pull the knot and put two halves of it together. It twisted again in a string lace.
- The colors of signs on the chart do not exactly correspond to the threads colors, they are chosen to make the chart more readable.

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
